Power Consignor Fact Sheet

What is a Power Consignor?

- A seller who brings more than 300 items to the event.
 - Each tag counts as one item (one tag may contain multiple items such as shorts paired with a top). The total item count is based on what is dropped off - not necessarily what is in the seller's tagging account

Do Power Consignors need to schedule a Drop-off appointment?

- We ask that all Power Consignors make a Drop-off appointment for the Glen Mills event. The appointments are optional for the Wynnewood and Newark events.
 - Appointments can be scheduled by going to the "Consignor Details" tab of our website and looking for the Consignor Drop-off section. (Please email kelly@jbfsc.com if you cannot make our Power Consignor Drop-off window)

Are Power Consignors charged any additional fees?

- Power Consignors will be charged a \$30 fee (in addition to the \$12.50 consignor fee) if they don't mark ALL of their items to donate. This fee is waived for Power Sellers who complete a two-hour sort shift.

How can I schedule a sort shift?

- Sort shifts can be scheduled by logging into your account and selecting the "Team Member" button.

How do I earn the extra % on my sold items + fulfill the sorting requirement?

- Sellers can earn 10% of their items by competing a four hour shift AND a two hour sort shift.
